
Dog and Pony Show, CORE New Art Space, Denver, CO

This diptych contrasts the personalities of two well-known men by way of line quality: each face was digitally drawn and abstracted using an algorithm roughly based on their documented personality types. Please consider the following quote a short artist's statement about this series:
