

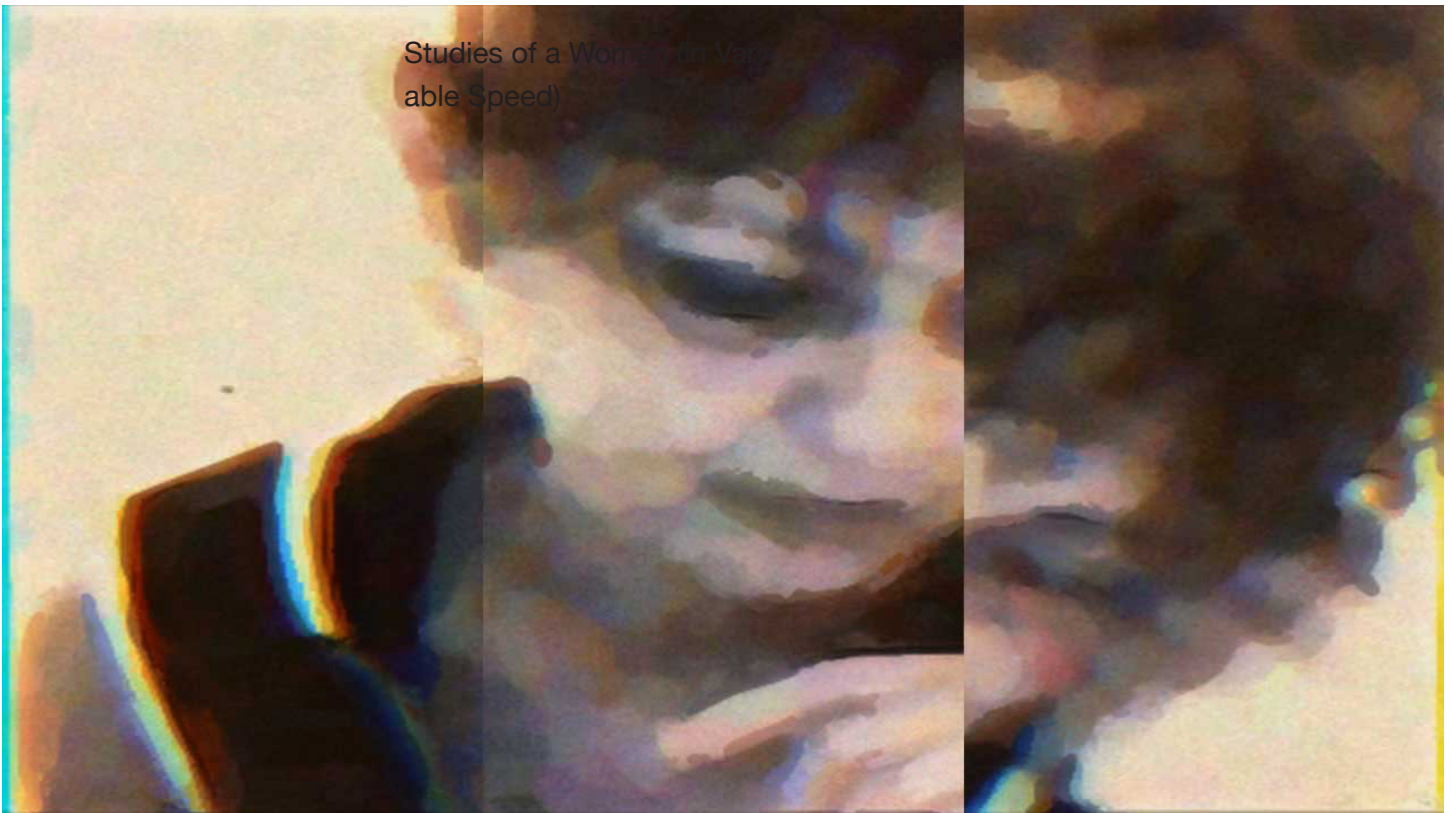

# Magmart International Videoart Festival, Casoria Contemporary Art Museum, Naples, Italy


